C/S - PRAVDA SAYS ARMS CACHES FOUND (W/CN - 41)

MOSCOW, SEPT 10 (UPI) - THE SOVIET PARTY NEWSPAPER PRAVDA TODAY REPORTED THE ALLEGED DISCOVERY OF ARMS CACHES IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

IT SAID 55 AUTOMATIC RIFLES, 8 MACHINE GUNS, 17 PISTOLS, THREE CARBINES AND 42 BOXES OF AMMUNITION WERE FOUND IN THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL BUILDING, THE POST OFFICE IN BRATISLAVA, AND THE TELEVISION STUDIO.

IT ALSO CLAIMED A SOVIET OFFICER HAD BEEN KILLED BY A SHOT FIRED FROM THE NATIONAL COUNCIL BUILDING.

THE PRAVDA CORRESPONDENT IN BRATISLAVA SAID THREE RIFLES WITH TELESCOPIC SIGHTS WERE FOUND IN THE HOME OF A MAN IDENTIFIED AS ANTON SAGAS.
